

Foliage in Watercolour

This is for those who have some basic watercolour skills.

We will work with flowers and fruits, and using techniques useful for landscape painting.

Participants will be encouraged to work free and loose; must have some drawing background and be engaged with individual capabilities and style.

Discussion of brushes and simple use of some Chinese brushwork techniques.

Materials:

Brushes – bring along brushes you have – if you have a dagger or fine Chinese brushes, take these along.

Palette and watercolour tubes or pans.

A soft pencil and a waterproof ink pen.

Tissues or a piece of kitchen paper towel.

Paper, 150 gsm to 200gsm, A4 or A3 size.

You will be provided with some rice paper to experiment.
