Call for nominations of Honorary Life Membership

We are calling for nominations for Honorary Life Membership to be awarded to a financial member who has made exemplary service and contribution to Colour Circle over an extended period of time (greater than 10 years). The award is for life and the status recognises a select group of leaders and contributors who have played a distinguished role in the development and success of the Colour Circle. The award will be in the form of a certificate and plaque as well as a lifetime membership to be awarded at the AGM. Life membership will be limited to one per year but is not necessarily granted each year.

If you have someone in mind who is deserving of such an award, please nominate them by filling in a nomination form. Forms can be found in the studio along with the Criteria and Procedures for nominating and awarding Life Membership.

All nominations need to be seconded and returned to the Karen Stack, chair of the Life membership sub-committee by **1**st **February 2024.** Nominations can be left in the studio box or emailed to thecolourcircle@gmail.com.

Procedures and Criteria for Awarding Life Membership to the Colour Circle

- Honorary Life Membership may be conferred on a member for exemplary service and contribution to Colour Circle over a cumulative period of at least 10 years. All nominations will be considered by a Life Membership Sub-Committee taking into account the following areas:
- 2. Service provided in a committee or executive capacity and/or supportive role.
- 3. Active participation much greater than the average member.
- 4. The quality, effectiveness and innovation of personal contributions.
- 5. Contributions towards the aims of Colour Circle.

- 6. The award is for life and the status recognises a select group of leaders and contributors who have played a distinguished role in the development and success of the Colour Circle. A certificate will be awarded, and no further membership fee is required in the case of an individual member.
- 7. Nominations for Life Membership must be seconded and must be made on the attached "Nomination for Life Membership" form addressing the stated criteria.
- 8. Nominations may be made by any financial member of Colour Circle including members of the Life Membership Sub-Committee. If a member of the Life Membership Sub-Committee makes a nomination, they must declare their interest and excuse themselves from any discussion regarding the candidate. Members of the Committee may not be selected to receive this honour during their term on the Committee.
- 9. Life Membership is limited to one per year, but it is not necessary for a Life Membership to be granted each year. However, in its first year of operation, there is the ability to appoint a number of Life Members.
- 10. In the event that there is more than one nomination, the Life Membership Sub-Committee will consider all nominations and then by secret ballot determine which nomination will be considered for Life Membership that year. There will then be a second secret ballot to determine if that nominee will be recommended for the award of Life Membership.
- 11. The General Committee will meet prior to the AGM to make a decision on the Life Membership Sub-Committee's recommendation. If approved, the nominee is presented to the general members and the Life Membership conferred at the AGM.
- 12. Total Life Memberships may not exceed 5% of the financial membership at any time. In the event that the membership declines, and Life Memberships exceed 5% no new nominations for Life Membership will be considered until membership increases.
- 13. The Colour Circle reserves the right to revoke the granting of Life Membership in extreme circumstances should the actions and behaviours of the relevant individual be deemed to be detrimental to the honour of the organisation and the arts sector more broadly.
