

Australian Floral Art in Oils with Nicolette Munro

One Day - Sunday 13th September 9.30-3.30 pm

Suitable for all levels

In this one-day workshop you will produce a beautiful oil painting of an Australian Floral still life from a photographic reference. In the morning, your tutor Nikki Munro will demonstrate how to capture the shape and likeness of Australian flowers and their unique leaves with time to practice painting their form and shape. In the afternoon you will be guided through the process of painting a still life image on a 30cm x 25cm canvas board.

You will learn:

- How to mix dynamic colours to represent flowers and leaves,
- How to use tonal variation to represent the shape of a vase,
- How to mix paint wet on wet for a contemporary painting

The workshop will be conducted in an open and supportive environment.

- Ultramarine Blue
- Cadmium Yellow
- Lemon Yellow
- Cadmium red
- Alizarin crimson
- Burnt Sienna
- If you don't have these exact colours don't worry, just bring what you have
- Pencil
- Paint brushes in various sizes 1-5 in round, bright and flat edge, just whatever you have.

**** Please note that your tutor will provide primed and coloured canvas paper for preliminary work and a primed canvas board for each participant. This will add an additional \$10.00 to the usual workshop fee**
