## ATMOSPHERIC WATERCOLOUR LANDSCAPES

Focused on creating a relaxed, inclusive and supportive learning environment, Ruth will provide activities to heighten your observational skills and your watercolour techniques. Learn;

- to use a limited palette and explore the variety of colours possible when creating atmosphere
- discover the effects to be gained using wet on wet techniques in watercolour
- to understand tones and how the values of your colours and applications can enhance your work
- to use pencils to break down images into simple tones to guide values and the structure of your composition

This is very much an exploratory workshop. Ruth will encourage your individual ability and experimentation through discussion, guided process and activities. At the conclusion of the day participants are encouraged to share the day's work through a discussion.

Paper: A4 and /or A3 100% cotton rag watercolour paper, preferably 300gsm or heavier. I use Arches. (We will be using wet on wet techniques which require robust, heavy rag paper.)

Sketch pad for drawing purposes

Pencils: HB, 2B and/or 4B

Brushes: Watercolour brushes - preferably a hake brush or large mop brush, number 12 or 14 and number 8 sable brushes.

Paints: Paynes grey (Cotmans and Schminke blue hue work best), plus greens, Windsor red or similar, indigo and /or ultramarine blue, yellow ochre, mid yellow.

Board, Masking tape, jar, palette

Images will be provided and you are welcome to bring your own photos.
